INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Opportunity to Explore, Experiment and Learn....

CESS internship programme provides opportunity to students at Undergraduate level and Postgraduate level from diverse background to develop new skills and explore career opportunities keeping education as a focal point in the areas of School Education, Higher education, social science, technology and innovation in education, teacher education, curriculum, skill development, employability and pedagogy, etc. The interdisciplinary nature of internship program with education as a focus area would help in addressing myriad social issues effectively and efficiently and play a vital role in breaking the silos in academics and research areas.

Nature of Project Internship

- The Internship offered candidate will align with the CESS current projects or any project as per candidates' choice with focus on education and social studies.
- The project work will be a study on a problem concerning society or an issue relating to education. This could be in the nature of desk study or a field study or extension work or preparation of detailed project report of an idea or exploration of a solution to the problem or implementation of an idea or a project or of any other which reflects the spirit of the regulations. A mini research or collection and/or analysis of primary and secondary data, or a case study can also be undertaken.

- The social problem or an issue relating to education is undertaken by the intern could relate to any organization or general in nature, which is not specific to any one organization. This includes inter-organization or comparative studies also.
- The word organization includes the following
 - a. Educational Institution
 - b. Government Department
 - c. NGO/ CSO/ Voluntary Organization
 - d. Research Body or Development Agency
 - e. Panchayat Raj Institutions
 - f. Local Municipal Body, Legislature, Court, Etc.
 - g. Micro, Small, Medium or Large Business Organization in any sector

How Internship at CESS is beneficial?

The CESS internship program provides an open minded, inspiring and encouraging environment to engage with dynamic people from diverse background working on different areas of education. The collaborative nature of workspace, unique program as CESS talk, in-house presentations, the wide networks with area specialists and organization provides a wide scope to students for self-empowerment. It enables the candidates to contribute to a larger purpose of social transformation.

Intern Responsibilities

1. Primary research tasks, literature survey, review, report, working paper etc
2. Attending meetings and others programs on educational issues and represent CESS at public events
3. Interview multi-stakeholders related to education; incorporate findings and recommendations into reports
4. Report to the guide and seek guidance from the project guide allotted by CESS
5. Maintaining a work diary of tasks assigned and work done on a daily basis and submitting it to the guide once a week

6. Final presentation, report submission to the CESS on internship accomplishments and feedback

Minimum Requirements

1. Intern should be a student of recognized educational institution
2. Candidate could be either from Undergraduate or Post-Graduate level
3. Candidate should be not below 5th or 6th semester in case of under graduation internship
4. Statement of Purpose (not more than 300 words) explaining the reason for choosing Internship with CESS along with CV

Terms & Conditions

1. Minimum 30 days and maximum of 90 days within which the intern has to complete the report and presentation
2. Internship is unpaid; however, the travel and other related expenses will be borne by CESS on a case to case basis
3. Only on successful completion of the internship duration and task assigned the intern would get a recognition/completion certificate
4. Intern to work under the intern-supervisor attached by the Institute
5. Interns should abide the rules and regulations of the Institute

Selection Process

1. Submission of CV and SOP (mail to gowrisha@cessedu.org)
2. Selected candidates will be called for an interview
3. Successful candidates will be intimated
